NOTICE OF RACE

The Flying Scot New England District Championship Regatta (“Regatta”) organizing authority is the Stone Horse Yacht Club.

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 („RRS“).
- 1.2. The class rules shall be the rules of the Flying Scot Class („Class Rules“).
- 1.3. Rules may be changed and these changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions, or as amendments to the Sailing Instructions (See Section 7 of this Notice).
- 1.4. By participating in this regatta, a competitor grants to the organization authority and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures, and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.

2. Racing Divisions

- 2.1. There will be two divisions for this Regatta: a Championship Division and Challenger Division.

3. Eligibility & Entry

- 3.1. The regatta is open to qualified boats of the Flying Scot Class.

4. Registration

- 4.2 Participants may also register in person at the Stone Horse Yacht Club from 00730 to 0830 on August 5, 2017
- 4.3 The early entry fee for online registrations by Friday, August 4th is \$50.
- 4.4 The fee for onsite registration is \$70.
- 4.5 The registration fee includes 2 Tee Shirts, racing activity, and food/beverage refreshments to include a continental breakfast, lunch makings, and a post race cookout on Saturday, August 5th
